The FIREFIGHTER provides fire and emergency response services as a member of the Fire Services team, including medical emergencies and provides medical support within their scope of practice. The firefighter is a contributor to the achievement of the department's operational deliverables.

A minimum of 18 years old, a high school diploma or equivalent, certification in National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 1001-Level I & II, NFPA 1002 Operator, pump, and aerial (or equivalent) and minimum First Medical Responder (FMR) medical certificate is required. Two (2) years firefighting experience with a recognized fire department and knowledge of fire emergency scenes is required. A combination of education and experience may be considered.

A service focus with good communication and interpersonal skills are required in order to communicate instructions clearly (both verbally and in writing), ensure mutual understanding and encourage participation and teamwork in the implementation and coordination of work.

Must possess a class 3 driver's license with Q endorsement (airbrakes). Successful security clearance for the vulnerability sector is required.

Must be able available for shift work and successfully complete a medical and psychological health assessment.
