This course is available to members of recognized emergency services organizations. This course is being delivered over 6 months online with one (1) practical day on June 23, and the exam and practical evaluations on June 26th at the Kananaskis Emergency Services Centre. Students will be required to purchase their own textbook: IFSTA Company Officer 6th Edition. The textbook is available from the Alberta Fire Chief's Association bookstore.

Prerequisites: NFPA 1021 Level I Fire Officer for ProBoard and IFSAC certification.

A 50% deposit is required to reserve a seat in the course. Deposits are non-refundable if canceled within two weeks of the start date.

A schedule will be provided ahead of the January 10th start date; each chapter will commence approximately a month apart. This will require the logging in and watching the lecture and completing assignments each month.
