 - Advanced First Aid at the FMR level, BLS CPR. (Equivalent 80hr course)
- Possess a valid Alberta unrestricted Class 3 driver's license with air brake endorsement (Q) or equivalent from another province.
- Airport Firefighting certification and experience would be preferred, but not a requirement.
